## Parking Lot

There are two entrances to the parking lot at the studio. Parents, please enter the lot on the North entrance and exit the lot on the South entrance. If we have a continuous flow, the traffic should move smoothly through the area. Please be aware that there are other businesses working with children in the area and there will be many children in the parking lot. Watch out for the children. Also please avoid parking in the stalls on the north side of the parking lot facing the post office. The church located directly across from the studio has asked that we leave those spaces for their patrons.

## Nutcracker Auditions

The South Pointe Ballet Company will be performing *The Nutcracker* this season. We are very excited about this opportunity. Registration for the auditions will be on Wednesday, September 12, and Thursday, September 13 from 4:30-7:00 p.m. Every dancer needs to register where they will be measured and receive a time for their auditions. Auditions will be held on Saturday, September 15. There is a \$10.00 registration fee due at the time of registration.

We do not have performance dates yet, but *The Nutcracker* will be held at Copper Mountain Jr. High School.

## Newsletters

## Payment Options

Tuition payments will be collected by direct deposit. If you are currently set up on this method, please give written permission to continue for the new dance year. If you are not currently set up, please fill out the form attached with the e-mail and bring it to the studio the first week of classes. Tuition will be drawn from accounts on the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month unless other arrangements have been made. We also now accept Venmo, credit cards, and PayPal.

## School Policies

Tuition is due the first class of each month. Tuition received after the 10th of the month will receive a \$10.00 late fee. Dress codes will be enforced. No skirts or shorts will be allowed in the ballet classes and hair must be pulled up in a bun. If you come prepared to dance, your class will be much more effective. Jazz classes need to come in dance clothing; a leotard and dance pants with the proper shoes. Tap classes need to come in dance clothing and tap shoes. Please help your student be prepared for class each week.

## Studio Fees

There is a \$25.00 performance fee that is due each dance year. This fee covers the cost of the performances. The costume fees cover the cost of the costumes. All of these fees are due by October 31, 2018. The \$20.00 registration fee is due at the time of registration.
